Project 1: Digital Collage

Create a large photo-composition in photoshop, 18x24" or larger, 300 DPI. The subject matter is up to you.

Make something meaningful.

You must use imagery from 4 or more different sources. These can be online searches (Google, social media, research databases), photos you take, or digital scans that you make in the lab.

Your composition must use 4 or more layers.

Use the techniques learned in class (Layers, Masks, Brightness/Contrast, Hue/Saturation, Adjustment Layers, as well as the advanced Clone Stamp, Healing Brush, Spot Healing, Content Aware Move) to create your composition.

You will print your final image in the digital photography lab, at a minimum of 18 x 24", 300 DPI. So pay attention to resolution in your source imagery.

We will critique the physical printouts in class.

Turn in a final, high res jpg as well as your photoshop (.psd) file on blackboard, zipped into one file.
